Applying for a School Place

A reminder to parents of children who start school in September. There is just over a week left to apply for a school place. Please remember to do so by **Saturday**, **15**th **January 2022**.

Lunches

If your child is at nursery for afternoon sessions and you would like your child to have a hot lunch, they are available for £2.35 per meal direct from Chartwells. They are able to cater for vegetarians and special dietary requirements (medical proof required), and are managed by you from home (10 days in advance). If your child is starting school in September, this offers you an opportunity to introduce hot lunches, as all reception children are entitled to hot lunches for free.

If you would like to order, please follow this <u>link</u> to register, book and pay. Please put "Leechpool School" as the school name and "Caterpillars" as the class. Hot meals are not compulsory, and your child is welcome to continue to bring in a health packed nut-free lunch box.

Please Label Belongings

A reminder to all our families, please ensure that all your child's belongings are clearly labelled including bags, lunch boxes, drinks, coats, hats, and gloves. We cannot stress enough how important this is, as we have 49 children in our nursery and identifying what item belongs to which child is very time consuming.

Illnesses

The winter months are well and truly upon us, and the usual winter germs are here. We ask for parents to be considerate to all our families when managing illnesses. If your child needs regular doses of Calpol to manage their symptoms, please keep your child at home to rest. This helps reduce the length of the illness and prevents passing the germs onto other children and staff.

As recommended by the government, please continue to carry out regular lateral flow tests and advise us of any positive results.

Stomach bugs are common this time of year. Please continue to follow the rules around vomiting and diarrhoea by keeping your child at home for 48-hours after their last episode.

Changes to the Leadership Structure at Leechpool Caterpillar Nursery & After-School Club

We are excited to tell you that Leechpool Caterpillar Nursery and After-School Club have officially move to being under the umbrella of Leechpool Primary School and its Governing Body since September 2021. The previous Management Committee has been dissolved in line with the wishes of the old committee and all authorities have been handed over to the School and Governing Body.

Caterpillars and Leechpool Primary have a strong working relationship which ensures continuity between the school children who attend Caterpillars After-School Club and also strong transition links for nursery children moving on to the primary school.

Caterpillars and Leechpool's Leadership teams work with the Governing Body to ensure the quality of education and value for money is achieved. All decision making regarding Caterpillar Nursery and After-School Club is made in conjunction with Leechpool School and the Governors of the school. This is a positive move as it will enable future development and growth for all parties.

At Leechpool, the Governing Body is highly valued, with teamwork being a priority at all times. The Governors work with the school, nursery and After-School Club, with the aim of improving standards and striving for excellence. The governors take a hands-on approach to their role and assist with school events such as fayres, fundraising events, outings and special events. Governors also attend classes, nursery and After-School Club to monitor the impact of teaching and learning and care of the children, inset, training days and inspections.
